Jim Nathan, president, Lee Memorial Health System (LMHS), will visit Sanibel on Thursday, April 10, at 7:00 p.m. to present his views on the health care crisis facing Southwest Florida and beyond. This community-wide event, sponsored by the Zonta Club of Sanibel-Captiva, will be held at the Sanibel Community Association, 2173 Periwinkle Way.

Jim Nathan is a nationally renowned health care expert and visionary, as well as a local leader, who is well known by many on Sanibel.
